Section 23A of the State Construction Code of Act of 1972, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972. Being Section 125.1523A of the Michigan Compiled Laws, prohibited a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building structure. Violators of Section 23A are subjected to civil fines.
